Frequently Asked Questions

What is a subcommittee member?

Subcommittee members are volunteers responsible for assisting a certain portfolio, such as Education, Careers, with planning and logistics for EconSoc's events. This can include helping any executive with setting up booths & help write advertising material - it can vary greatly.

Why should I be a subcommittee member?

Firstly, being part of a subcommittee is great if you want to become a future executive, as you are exposed to the leadership team and see the behind-the-scenes and planning of events. Secondly, you can gain valuable, employable skills throughout your time as a subcommittee member. These can include event planning, media management, publishing experience, direct teamwork abilities and time management skills.

What is the application process?

First there is an online application form that includes your resume, your skills and your motivations for becoming a subcommittee member. You also fill in your preferences for which subcommittee you would like to join. From there, you may be selected to conduct an interview. If you make it through the in-person interviews, you will be invited to our subcommittee induction, where we will give you an introduction to ourselves and give you a rundown on what your responsibilities are.
